3.1	Dredging – recent offer to share a dredging vessel with Eyemouth and Amble harbours has been discounted. Need for any future licences and methods are being investigated.	FK

4.1	There is no new update. GR-T to contact, as per previous meeting, David Smith MP re invite and meet/ greet at Harbour and HRO current position and expected timescale.	GR-T

5.1	CCTV – estimated start date 4 March. JD Vision is to meet with Ad-Hoc and FK onsite. GA mentioned that there are no lights at freezers – FK confirmed this is part of the ongoing improvements.	FK
5.2	Power pedestals - First pedestal has been installed and software set up on new laptop. Casing being re-assessed re fit by Oswald Hughes prior to proceeding with all pedestals.	
5.3	Pontoon/Wall survey – Core survey completed to 1.5m. Pull test to be carried out.	
	Installation scheduled for mid-March. Due to length of time since original quote there may be an increase to some costs. Handrails need to be considered at pier side. During installation the harbour steps can still be used with public being guided by pleasure boat staff / NSH staff and clear signage will be in-situ. Once in place disabled access will be hugely improved for our visitors.	
	TD indicated that the Insurance Broker is aware of additional coverage required when Pontoon in-situ.	TD/FK

6.1	There was a discussion on consultant fees. Debtors – FK shared debtor information and is attempting to address aged debt with those individuals.	Ongoing FK
6.2	It was agreed that from 1 April 2025 any local/ frequent visitor vessel (e.g. for safe haven) would be issued a Berthing Agreement and be expected to pay ad hoc Landing Dues but no 'minimum' amount charged as not resident berth holder.	FK/KCB
6.3	The question of fuel duty (and VAT on fuel) was discussed. FK has sought advice from GWA and will advise further in due course.	FK

	limited to approx. 10 vessels. There has been a request for 3 or 4 berths for local	
	(parish) boat owners in outer harbour and it was agreed that this should be	
	considered and then agreed at next meeting – consideration to be given to residents	
	of the Parish first / size of vessel (potential to limit to under 8m) and if they can	FK/KCB
	easily remove in inclement weather.
